About Energy Law Summer School

The Energy Law Summer School is the first summer school of its kind in Slovenia, coorganised by the European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER). The program is designed to provide in-depth knowledge and insights into the **most pressing issues in the energy sector** today.

Participants will engage with topics such as the integration of the European electricity market, gas crisis, and innovative approaches to decarbonisation. The programme includes compelling case studies that highlight various challenges and solutions. A special focus will be placed on ACER's pivotal role in shaping the single European electricity and natural gas markets.

The Energy Law Summer School not only offers a unique academic experience but also provides valuable networking opportunities with leading experts and industry professionals. Additionally, participants will gain insights into career opportunities within ACER.

The Summer School will be held in English.

Application procedure

Who can apply?

The Energy Law Summer School is aimed at **graduate and postgraduate students**, as well as **researchers** in legal and related disciplines who have an interest in or focus on **energy law**.

Students who successfully complete the summer school will receive two (2) ECTS credits.

What is the application procedure?
